A RESOLUTION CANVASSING THE VOTE OF THE 02 NOVEMBER 2021 SPECIAL ELECTION AND DECLARING ITS RESULTS FOR PROPOSITION A: AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF UNIVERSAL CITY, TEXAS, TO PROVIDE THAT FOR A PERSON WHO IS DISABLED OR IS SIXTY-FIVE (65) YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER THAT THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF AD VALOREM TAXES IMPOSED ON THAT HOMESTEAD BY THE CITY MAY NOT BE INCREASED WHILE IT REMAINS THE RESIDENCE HOMESTEAD OF THAT PERSON OR THAT PERSON'S SPOUSE WHO IS DISABLED OR SIXTY-FIVE (65) YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER PURSUANT TO TEXAS CONSTITUTION ARTICLE VIII, SECTION 1-B.

WHEREAS, The City Council of the City of Universal City, Texas, ordered an election (Resolution 922) to be held in the City on Tuesday, November 2, 2021, on PROPOSITION A hereinafter stated; and

WHEREAS, The City Council of the City of Universal City convened in Regular Meeting on the 9th day of November 2021, at the City Hall, and the roll was called of the duly constituted officers and members of said City Council, and it was found that all members of said Council were present, thus constituting a quorum; and

WHEREAS, The City Council has investigated all matters pertaining to said election, including the ordering, giving notice, officers, holding and making returns of said election; and

WHEREAS, The Bexar County and Guadalupe County Elections Administrators who conducted said election has duly made the returns of the result thereof and said returns have been duly delivered to the City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF UNIVERSAL CITY. TEXAS. THAT:

- 1. The City Council officially finds and determines that said election was duly ordered; proper notice of said election was duly given; proper election officers were duly appointed prior to said election; said election was duly held; the City has complied with the Federal Voting Rights Act and the Texas Election Code; due returns of the result of said election have been made and delivered; and the City Council has duly canvassed said returns, all in accordance with law and the Resolution calling the election.
- 2. The City Council officially finds and determines that 2,334 total votes were cast by resident, qualified electors of the City, with 1,520 electors casting their ballots during Early Voting, 201 absentee ballots cast, and 613 electors casting their ballots on Election Day.
- 3. The City Council officially finds and determines that the following votes were cast at said election on the submitted PROPOSITION A by the resident, qualified electors of the City who voted at the election:

4. The City Council officially finds, determines, and declares the result of said election to be that the PROPOSITION A so submitted has received a favorable majority vote in all respects and has carried by a majority vote of 1,640.
