

## CERTIFICATE OF PETITION SUFFICIENCY

This certificate is issued to satisfy the requirements of Article VIII, Section 1-b(h) of the Texas Constitution in conformance with Section 277.002 of the Texas Election Code.

Whereas, an initiative petition was filed in the office of the City Clerk of the City of Universal City on April 1, 2021, from duly registered voters of the City of Universal City, Texas, styled:

“We, the undersigned qualified voters of the City of Universal City, Texas, in accordance with Chapter 277 of the Texas Election Code, hereby petition the City Council of the City of Universal City, Texas to call an election to determine by majority vote whether to establish an ad valorem tax limitation for seniors and the disabled.”

Whereas, provisions of the Texas Constitution, Article VIII, Section 1-b(h), provides that the minimum number of signatures required for the petition to be sufficient is not less than 5% of the registered and qualified voters for Universal City.

Whereas, according to the Registered Voter Report provided by the Bexar County Elections Department on April 1, 2021, there were 11,456 qualified voters in Universal City.


Whereas, each page of the petition submitted contained signatures purported to be the signatures of qualified electors of Universal City; that attached to each petition at the time it was filed was an affidavit professing to be the affidavit of the persons who solicited the signatures, and containing the dates between which the purported qualified electors signed the petition; that the affiant stated their own qualifications, that they had solicited the signatures upon that page, that all of the signatures were made in their presences, and that to the best of their knowledge and belief each signature was the genuine signature of the person whose name it purports to be.

Whereas, after the proponents filed the petition, I, Kristin Mueller, City Clerk for the City of Universal City, Texas, determined the following facts regarding the petition:

Total number of signatures required to qualify petition:	573
Total number of signatures filed by proponent:	982
Total number of signatures verified:	982
Total number of signatures found sufficient:	851
Total number of signatures found insufficient:	131

Because the number of valid signatures on said petition is 851, or 7% of the registered and qualified voters for Universal City, I hereby certify that I have received and reviewed signatures on a petition requesting the City Council of the City of Universal City, Texas to call an election to determine by majority vote whether to establish an ad valorem tax limitation for seniors and the disabled under the Texas Constitution.
