Universal City residential recycling day is every other week as identified by the map on the reverse side of this page. Residents who live on North Blvd., between areas C&E will be serviced under area C. Residents who live on Kitty Hawk Rd, between areas B and C will be serviced under area B.

Brush Collection: Saturday for all areas. Brush and yard waste to be bagged and bundled! Tree trimmings to be bundled and tied, not to exceed 5' in length and 4" in diameter; bundles not to exceed 35 lbs each

Bulky Item Collection

Bulky items will be collected second garbage pick up day of the week

The clean ups are for non Hazardous larger items: furniture, appliances, tree limbs etc.

RECYCLE ITEMS

Paper: Most types of paper, such as ad circulars catalogs, carbonless paper, dry goods packaging with liners removed. envelopes, file folders, flattened cardboard, junk mail, magazines, newspapers, office paper paperback books, paper bags, paper towel/toilet paper core phone books, non-metallic gift wrap

Plastics: Labeled #1 through #7. Look for the recycling symbol  on the bottom. Remove lids and rinse. Examples include beverage bottle, shampoo and lotion bottles, meat trays condiment bottles, prescription and medicine bottles, plastic grocery bags tied together into bundle.

Metal Cans: Aluminum, steel and tin beverage and food cans rinse all food or liquids, aerosol cans, empty and remove nozzle, baking tins, rinse and remove remaining food

Glass Bottles and Jars All Colors: Remove lids and rinse all food and liquids. Examples: beverage bottles, food and condiment bottles and jars.
