



**“KICK THE CAN” REBATE APPLICATION**  
For Universal City Water Customers Only



The City of Universal City is offering a \$75 rebate check to its citizens when they replace their old water-wasting toilets with a new water-efficient toilet (limit two for a total of \$150 per household).

This offer is valid for homes built prior to 1992 and is for Universal City water customers only. **NEW HOMES AND BATHROOM ADDITIONS BUILT AFTER 1992 as well as EXISTING LOW FLOW TOILETS ARE NOT ELIGIBLE.**

1. Replace your old toilet with a new 1.6 or less gallon per flush toilet. You can install it yourself or have your plumber install it. **DO NOT DISPOSE OF THE OLD TOILET(S) UNTIL THE INSPECTOR CONFIRMS THE TYPE OF TOILET THAT HAS BEEN REPLACED.**
2. After installation, call the Public Works Department at 658-5364 to schedule an inspection. The rebate cannot be issued until inspection and approval from Public Works personnel.

3. **ATTACH YOUR ORIGINAL SALES RECEIPT TO YOUR COMPLETED APPLICATION. Give the completed application to the water division inspector. Sales receipt must be dated within 60 days of request for reimbursement. Allow 30 days for processing.**
4. Place the old toilets for pickup with your regular trash collection.

In accepting this rebate I acknowledge that the City of Universal City is in no way responsible for the condition of the plumbing on my side of the water meter now or in the future.
